She is an effective manager of editorial projects and skilled developer of columnists and reporters.

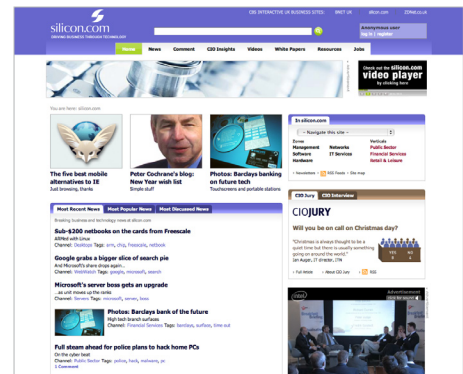
